

**Fr. Jerry Siebold, C.Ss.R.** — The closing song for Fr. Jerry Siebold's Mass of the Resurrection was "We are Called." The refrain, "We are called to act with justice, we are called to love tenderly, we are called to serve one another; to walk humbly with God!" embodies how Jerry strived to live his life as a Redemptorist. Jerry was born on September 20, 1932 to John and Lydia Siebold in San Antonio. He was professed on August 2, 1953 and ordained to the priesthood on June 24, 1958. He served on the faculty at Holy Redeemer Seminary until 1967. From 1967 until his retirement in 2003 he served in a number of parishes including St. Alphonsus in New Orleans, St. Anthony's and Uganda Martyrs in Okmulgee, OK, and finally at Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish in Crowley, LA. During his years as a Redemptorist missionary, Jerry never refused an assignment and faithfully ministered in all of his appointments. He loved his family as well as his flock, and he constantly preached the Gospel of his Redeemer. May he rest in eternal peace.
