Father Kelly entered the Redemptorist order at the age of 14. He was ordained a priest on June 17, 1951. Beginning with his assignment to the missions in Puerto Rico, he ministered among the Spanish speaking Christians. He was assigned to St. Mary Seminary in North East, Pennsylvania to work with the Hispanic students. Later he became the Director of Migrant Ministry in Delaware, Maryland, and Virginia and served as Pastor at Our Lady of Lourdes, Seaford, Maryland, St. Christopher Church, Kent Island, Maryland. He was assigned as Pastor at Immaculate Conception Church, Bronx, New York, St. Boniface, Philadelphia and St. Philomena, Pittsburgh. In addition to his parochial ministry, Father Kelly conducted many missions. For many years, beginning with Father Crowley's pastorate, Father John Kelly has assisted with Mass at Holy Angels Parish. Following the closure of St. Philomena Parish in Squirrel Hill, Father Kelly remained in Pittsburgh at the family home with his sisters, Regina, Sr. Kathleen, Sr. Elizabeth, and Sr. Ursula. In addition to his sister, Regina, Father Kelly was predeceased by his two brothers, Martin and Gerard.
