He also served in Edmonton, Yorkton, Grande Prairie and Calgary. At one point he was the Bursar at Holy Redeemer College Edmonton and a Vocation Director for the Province of Edmonton. In addition to his priestly duties he was very involved with the Knights of Columbus wherever he was stationed.

In 1999 he moved to the Redemptorist retirement community at Villa Marguerite in Edmonton which he was instrumental in organizing. He will be loved and greatly missed by his confreres in the Redemptorist Order, his family and his many friends which he made over the years.
