BROTHER WILLIAM PHILIP ROBERTS died at the age of 68 at St. Clement Health Care Center, Liguori, MO.

Born in Brooklyn, NY, March 31, 1937; professed at Ilchester, MD, October 16, 1957.

Brother William had the distinction of being a member of the three Provinces of the United States.

The first 25 years of his religious life was spent in the Baltimore Province.

In 1983 he transferred to the Oakland Province, and then at the 1996 merger became a member of the Denver Province.

Bro. William spent his life working in gay and lesbian ministry. He was internationally known as a resource person in Gay Celibate Spirituality.

He was a published author in this area and also published his own anonymous newsletter.

Bro. William loved the Palisades Retreat House in Washington and spent 17 years there ministering to make it a place of love and welcome.

He was a writer, organizer, artist, and forward thinker.

He died very peacefully at St. Clements Health Care Center from cancer.
