BENEDETTI Claudio

Was born in Falvaterra in the diocese of Veroli on 30th August 1841. He was ordained priest on 2nd April 1865, and after

studying in the Sapienza, Rome, gained the doctorate in utroque jure. He taught moral theology in the seminary of Veroli until he joined the Redemptorists. He made his profession in the house of Sant'Alfonso, Rome, on 27th July 1878. He taught dogmatic theology to the students of the Roman province and was for a time novice master. From 1890 until 1922 he was postulator general of the Congregation. He was much respected by authorities of the Holy See and served as consultor to more than one Sacred Congregation. Among the Pontifical Commissions to which he was appointed the most important was that for the preparation of the Code of Canon Law. Father Benedetti died in Rome on 29th February 1926.
