BOYLAN Andrew

Was born in Kilmore on 1st August 1842 and was ordained priest for that diocese on 31st March 1867. For some years he served as bursar to the seminary of Maynooth. Coming to the Redemptorists, he took his vows in Dundalk on 15th October 1888. In 1898 he was appointed first superior of the Irish province, holding that office until he was named Bishop of Kilmore on 18th April 1907. He travelled to the Philippines to arrange the foundation of the house in Opon, the first in that country, remaining for several months of 1906

in order to assist in the difficult beginnings. He died in Cavan in the episcopal residence on 25th March 1910.
