

HARTMAN Louis

Was born in New York on 17th January 1901. He took his vows as a Redemptorist in Ilchester on 2nd August 1922 and was ordained priest in Esopus on 19th 1927. After studying Oriental languages in the Catholic University of America he attended the Biblical Institute in Rome, where he graduated with the licentiate in Sacred Scripture in 1931. Further studies gained him the licentiate in Oriental languages in 1936. His knowledge of the Old Testament and Biblical languages was widely respected, and from 1948 he was general secretary of the Catholic Biblical Association. He taught in the studentate of Esopus and from 1950 in the Catholic University. He died in Washington on 22nd August 1870.
