HERMANN Jean

Was born in Rodern in Alsace on 14th January 1849. He took his vows as a Redemptorist in St.-Nicolas-du-Port on 8th December 1867 and was ordained priest in Avon on 18th July 1875. From the time of his ordination he was occupied in teaching the French students, first philosophy and then for most of his career dogmatic theology. During the troubled times at the end of the nineteenth century he went with the students to Holland, to England and to Belgium. His dogmatic writings were praised by Pius X for their orthodoxy. Father Hermann died in Fauguemont on 28th February 1927.
