MARC Clément

Was born in Jouy-sous-les-côtes in the diocese of Verdun on 24th July 1831. He took his vows as a Redemptorist in Saint-Nicolas-du-Port on 24th September 1853 and was ordained priest in Téterchen on 16th August 1857. After ordination he was occupied principally in teaching moral theology in Téterchen. He published his *Institutio*nes morales Alphonsianae in Rome in 1885, and in 1943 its twentieth edition appeared in Lyons. Father Marc was always devoted to pastoral duties, and contracted small pox while attending those affected by the disease. He died in Rome on 27th January 1887.
